

## **Approximate Cost of Raising a Lamb or Goat**

Ownership Deadline.....	October 1st, 2020
Entry fees.....	\$20 per head per show
Pen Rent/Medication.....	\$40 one time per pen
OR	
Pen Rent/Medication/Electrolytes.....	\$60 one time per pen
Tag.....	\$20 per head one time
Feed Cost per month.....	\$40 per month per head
Alfalfa Rotation.....	\$10 once every 2-4 months

## **Breeds of Sheep and Goats Prices**

Medium Wool Class (Suffolk and Hampshires).....	\$500 and up
Crossbred Class.....	\$500 and up
Fine Wool Class.....	\$500 and up
Southdown Class.....	\$500 and up
Boer Goats.....	\$400 and up
*Prices vary with gender as well, ewes will be cheaper than wethers.	

## **Cost of Owning and Raising One Sheep or Goat**

Feed cost (700lbs).....	\$280 +/- (\$20-\$18)Bag
Or \$36 to \$40 a month.	
Mineral Cost (25lbs).....	\$25 one time
Lamb and Goat Blankets.....	\$30-\$40 one time
Water Bucket (5 gal).....	\$10-\$15 one time
Feed Trough.....	\$15- \$20 one time
Supplements.....	\$15-\$25 per month not required but strongly suggested
Chain for Lead(goats).....	\$8 to \$20
Halter (Rope).....	\$5 to \$10
Muzzle.....	\$10 to \$12

Please do not try to hold us to them. Also not all money is due at once, the main cost is the purchase of the animal. The other money's are spread out over the months of ownership of the animal(s).
